MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS - EDUCATION, TRAINING AND/OR EXPERIENCE:

High school diploma or equivalent. Bilingual/biliterate in Spanish and English. One year experience working with children in an educational setting.

### DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS - EDUCATION, TRAINING AND/OR EXPERIENCE:

AA Degree. Three years experience working with children in an educational setting.

#### **SKILLS AND ABILITIES:**

Bilingual/biliterate in Spanish and English. Proof of valid California driver's license and be eligible to drive under SJCOE driving requirements. Must furnish own transportation as required to fulfill job duties.

#### **SUMMARY OF POSITION:**

Under direction of the Director of Migrant Education, Program Manager II, and Coordinator, the Migrant Service Tutor will support instruction to individual students in a home or a classroom setting. All programs, both classroom and home based, will focus on preparing students to successfully meet state academic standards. Migrant Service Tutor will involve parents in the process.

### **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:**

Essential functions may include, but are not limited to the following:

- 1. Assist migrant students in the development of their academic skills.
- 2. Assist students in meeting academic content standards for their grade level.
- 3. Provide instructional tutoring in the home of the students identified.
- 4. Organize and maintain schedule of student and parent contacts.
- 5. Communicate with the students' classroom teachers to identify their academic needs.
- 6. Communicate with parents and teachers regarding students' academic progress.
- 7. Assist the Migrant Early Childhood Specialist with home-school articulation.
- 8. Attend training on how to enhance the development of the academic skills of migrant students.
- 9. Attend all Migrant in-services and meetings as required.
- 10. Maintain records and submit reports in an accurate and timely manner.
- 11. Be a resource for the migrant students regarding other learning opportunities.
- 12. Maintain a positive and professional attitude at all times towards migrant children, parents, staff, and community members.
- 13. Provide a safe, stable environment conducive to the development of the children's concept of self and positive attitudes towards learning.
- 14. Exercise supervision and care over all furniture, books, supplies, and equipment entrusted to his/her care.
- 15. Maintain confidentiality regarding information concerning children and families.
- 16. Operate a motor vehicle.

- 17. Be able to make or assist with presentations to the public.
- 18. Conduct student assessments.
- 19. Perform other duties as required.

## **PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:**

Employees in this position must have the ability to:

- 1. Sit and stand for extended periods of time.
- 2. Possess manual dexterity needed to dial a telephone, to enter data into a computer, and perform assigned classroom tasks using both hands.
- 3. See and read a computer screen and printed matter with or without vision aids.
- 4. Hear and understand speech at normal levels and on the telephone.
- 5. Speak so that others may understand at normal levels and on the telephone.
- 6. Stand, walk, and bend over, reach overhead, grasp, push, pull and move, lift and/or carry up to 25 pounds to waist height.
- 7. Operate a vehicle in the course of carrying out assigned duties.

## WORK ENVIRONMENT:

Employees in this position will be required to work indoors and outdoors in an educational environment, and/or make home visitations. They will come in direct contact with students, SJCOE staff, district staff, migrant community and the public.

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
