Previous work with the Migrant community. Experience working in an educational setting.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- 3. Maintains records and prepares materials and reports as needed.
- 4. Makes mathematical calculations with speed and accuracy.
- 5. Performs other related duties as assigned.
